**2-year Advanced Film Award Program**

**Registration for Fall 2009 now being accepted,  
offered by the Theatre & Film Program at Saint Augustine's College**

**Raleigh, NC** — Saint Augustine's College offers the 2-year Advanced Film Award program, in addition to the 4-year Bachelor's degree in Theatre & Film. This program is designed for adults who wish to study directing, screenwriting, acting, and/or the technical side of filmmaking without pursuing an undergraduate degree or who already have a degree in another major. Each Advanced Film Award is designed to focus on the individual's specific goals. Fall classes start August 19, 2009.

This 24-credit program is designed to be completed within two years, with students taking two courses per semester. Students may take individual classes without completing the program. Courses are offered as part of the regular Theatre & Film college classes, taught during the normal class days and hours during the week. This Fall classes include Intro to Screenwriting, Documentary I, and Acting for the Camera (prerequisites may apply to certain classes). Classes taken through the Advanced Film Award program are non-accredited.

Students train in our soundstage and on location, editing with Avid non-linear editing systems and working with Canon & Panasonic digital cameras, Arri lighting systems, and Final Draft Screenwriting software.
