However, there are some items that create danger to persons, damage to College property, a fire/safety hazard, and/ or a public nuisance and must not be used, possessed, or stored in the residence halls (including student rooms). - Alarm Clock
- Bath mat
- Bedding, such as a comforter, mattress pad, pillow and sheets (standard twin)
- Coaxial Cable cord (minimum 15 feet)
- Computer or Laptop
- Cleaning supplies
- Curtains (optional)
- Ethernet cord (minimum 15 feet)
- Floor fan (non air conditioned buildings only)
- Fun stuff, such as pictures and posters
- Iron/Ironing Board
- Latch and/or Lock for closet
- Laundry Detergent, Fabric Softener and Laundry basket
- One refrigerator per room (maximum 4.3 cubic feet)
- Plastic ware (cup, plate, silverware)
- Shower caddy
- Shower curtain
- Shower shoes
- Small lamp
- Telephone and Answering Machine
- Television
- Toiletries
- Towels
- Umbrella
- Wastebasket
- UL approved surge protected power strip (one per student)

### What should I leave at home?

- All pets
- Anything that hangs from the ceiling
- Any type of halogen light
- Candles and incense
- Electrical cooking appliances (coffee pots, deep fryers, blenders, toasters, toaster ovens, sandwich makers, indoor grills, George Foreman grill, etc.)
- Exercise Weights/Equipment
- Extension cords
- Lava lamps
- Multi-plug extension cords
- Microwave oven
- Replicates of Guns (plastic, paint ball)
- Space heater
