APPLICATION PROCEDURES

We are pleased that you are interested in applying to Saint Augustine's College. Saint Augustine's College does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, color, religion, national origin, age, handicap, or veteran status in any of its policies, activities or access to its programs. In order to apply for admission to Saint Augustine's College, please adhere to the information below:

- A \$25 non-refundable fee (payable by check or money order only) must be submitted with this application.
- This application and fee are only valid for the semester that you indicate. However, you may defer the application and fee for one semester by notifying the Admissions Office, in writing, four weeks prior to the opening day of the semester indicated by your initial application. Otherwise, a new application and fee will be required.
- All applications and documents will be retained for one year following the semester for which you applied. After such time, applications and documents will be discarded if the applicant has *not enrolled* at the College or deferred the application to a later semester.

Application Deadlines

 Spring Semester.....December 1
 Summer Semester.....May 1

- All official documents **MUST** be received no later than four weeks prior to the beginning of the semester for which you are applying.

Freshman Applicants

Freshman applicants are students who are currently enrolled in high school or who graduated from high school and have not attended any accredited college or university (not to include dual enrollment) and must meet the following admission criteria:

- Must have taken either the ACT or SAT and have a minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 2.0 (C) on a 4.0 scale, or a minimum GED total score of 2250.
- Must submit an official high school transcript or an official GED score report
- Must submit official American College Test (ACT Code: 3152) or Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT Code: 5596) scores.
- Must submit two (2) letters of recommendation (may be mailed separately).
- Dual enrolled students should submit ALL college transcripts to be evaluated for transferring credit
- Home schooled applicants must contact the Office of Admissions for specific requirements.

Freshman Checklist

- OFFICIAL transcripts from ALL high schools attended or OFFICIAL GED scores
- ALL OFFICIAL SAT or ACT scores

Transfer Applicants

Transfer applicants are students who are currently enrolled or have attended an accredited college and/or university after graduation from high school or receiving a GED. Transfer students must be academically, financially, and socially eligible to return in good standing to their former institution(s) and must meet the following admissions criteria:

- Must meet freshmen and transfer requirements
- Applicant must request that all official transcripts (high school and college) and test scores be sent to the Office of Admissions.
