Falcons Release 2008 Football Schedule

RALEIGH, NC – Four home games including one against crosstown rival Shaw highlight Saint Augustine's College's 2008 football schedule, which was released Monday (May 5).

The Falcons host non-conference foe Mars Hill in their home opener on Sept. 13 and play Shaw at home on Oct. 4. It will be the first home game against Shaw since 2005 when the Falcons won 33-0. In addition to Mars Hill and Shaw, the Falcons host long-time CIAA foe Fayetteville State (Donor Appreciation Day) on Oct. 25 and CIAA newcomer Chowan (Homecoming/Senior Day) on Nov. 1. All home games start at 1:30 p.m.

The Falcons open the regular season with back-to-back non-conference road games. They visit Catawba on Aug. 30 at 7 p.m. and the University of Charleston (W.Va.) on Sept. 6 at 1 p.m.

The rest of the away schedule features four CIAA teams. The Falcons face Virginia State on Sept. 20 at 6 p.m., Elizabeth City State in the annual Down East Viking Classic in Rocky Mount, NC, on Sept. 27 at 4 p.m., Johnson C. Smith on Oct. 11 at 6 p.m. and Livingstone on Oct. 18 at 3 p.m.
