**\$2.65 million USGA Award supports
Saint Augustine's College Junior Golf Program**

Raleigh, N.C. – More than 100 children in the Raleigh area will take advantage of the Meadowbrook Junior Golf Program during the first year of operation. The program is offered at the Saint Augustine's College Golf Course and Recreational Complex at Meadowbrook located in Garner, North Carolina.

The College is a first-time United States Golf Association (USGA) grant recipient. USGA has awarded 143 grants totaling \$2,650,935 to support golf programs across the nation for economically-disadvantaged juniors and individuals with disabilities.

The grant funds will be used for instruction, golf course and range access, equipment, transportation and the construction of accessible golf facilities.

In 1958, prominent leaders of the black community purchased Meadowbrook Country Club and Golf Course as an alternative for fellow residents who were not welcomed at segregated clubs across the state. The College acquired the historic country club in 2007 in an effort to maintain a piece of North Carolina's history
