### **Area Motorcyclists Raise Money for Scholarships**

**Raleigh, N.C.** - Throttles were pulled back and engines raced in efforts to help raise money for scholarships for students attending Saint Augustine's College. Motorcyclists from as far as Fayetteville gathered on the campus of Saint Augustine's College on Sunday, June 22, to lend their support to the Tom Joyner Foundation School of the Month campaign. In demonstration of unity and support, the cyclist took a 50 mile ride through Raleigh and into Wake Forest and then back to campus.

The North Carolina United Bikers Association (NCUBA) was the catalyst for the charity ride. Yvette Cannady, director of facilities at Saint Augustine's College and cyclist with Ebony Angels said, "This is what we do. NCUBA is about giving back to the community and supporting worthy causes."
