Registration for fall 2008 two-year Advanced Film Award Program for adults now being accepted

Raleigh, N.C. - In addition to the four-year bachelor's degree in Theatre & Film, Saint Augustine's College also offers a two-year Advanced Film Award program designed for adults who wish to study directing, screenwriting, and/or the technical sides of filmmaking without pursuing an undergraduate degree or who already have a degree in another major. Fall classes start Aug. 20.

This 24-credit program is designed to be completed within two years, with students taking two courses per semester. Students may take individual classes without completing the program. Courses are offered as part of the regular Theatre & Film curriculum, taught during the normal class days and hours during the week. Fall classes include Film Appreciation, Camera & Lighting, Intro to Screenwriting, Motion Picture Directing, Documentary I, and Film History & Criticism (pre-requisites may apply to certain classes). Each Advanced Film Award is designed to focus on the individual's specific goals.

Students train on the soundstage and on location, editing with Avid non-linear editing systems, working with Canon & Panasonic digital cameras, Arri lighting systems, and Final Draft Screenwriting software.
