Saint Augustine's College to host teaching and learning institute

Raleigh — Saint Augustine's College will host the UNCF/Mellon Teaching and Learning Institute, "Building Connections and Communities: Developing the Global Dimension in the College Curriculum," Sept. 12-13. The institute is funded by a \$24,891.40 grant from the Mellon Foundation and the United Negro College Fund.

The Faculty Teaching and Learning Institute will host several workshops for faculty and administrators from Saint Augustine's College as well as Johnson C. Smith University in Charlotte, Tougaloo College in Tougaloo, Miss., and Edward Waters College in Jacksonville, Fla. The sessions will focus on how to develop curriculum with an emphasis on globalization in the liberal arts disciplines.

Dr. Eve Stoddard, chair of the Department of Global Studies at St. Lawrence University, and Dr. Andrew Miller, director of Global Intercultural Experiences for Undergraduates at the University of Michigan, will facilitate the workshops and seminars.
