### **Students take on Obama, Clinton in debate**

Raleigh, NC – Senators Hillary Clinton and Barack Obama are in the middle of a heated race for the Democratic Party's presidential nomination, and Thursday, Feb. 7, Saint Augustine's College students will present their take on the candidates' campaigns and the issues.
