Dr. Linda R. Hubbard has been named assistant to the provost and director of the Center for Teaching and Learning at Saint Augustine's College. Hubbard most recently served as dean of the School of Education at Meredith College.

Hubbard's role in the College's Center for Teaching and Learning is to support faculty members in developing teaching strategies/methods that will motivate students to engage in the learning process. Faculty members can use the Center to connect with colleagues and share ideas, research studies and publications.

Hubbard holds a B.A. in Music and an M.A. in Guidance and Counseling from North Carolina Central University. She earned her Ph.D. in Special Education Administration and Educational Administration from Southern Illinois University – Carbondale.
