Tom Joyner Foundation kicks off scholarship campaign for Saint Augustine's College

Raleigh, NC - The Tom Joyner Foundation, a major driving force in raising money for historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs) since 1998, has kicked off an aggressive fundraising campaign for Saint Augustine's College. As one of the Tom Joyner Foundation Schools of the Month, Saint Augustine's College will receive funds raised from listeners, alumni and other interested parties during the month of June toward the "Investing in the Promise" campaign to reach a goal of \$400,000.

The Tom Joyner Foundation, formed by the nationally syndicated radio personality Tom Joyner, chose Saint Augustine's College as part of its ongoing effort to assist HBCUs in broadening and strengthening their efforts to raise money to help keep students attending these institutions.
