**THE EVENT**

Saint Augustine's College hosts Johnson C. Smith University in a big CIAA game. The winner remains in contention for the Western Division title and a berth in the CIAA Championship Game. The game is designated as Falcon Tribute Day.

**THE SERIES**

The Golden Bulls lead the series 15-13-1 including victories in the last two meetings between both teams. In 2008, the Golden Bulls won 19-13 in Charlotte, N.C. The Falcons hold a 4-2 edge in the series including a 2-1 edge at home since 2002. The last time both teams played in Raleigh, N.C., was 2007 when the Golden Bulls prevailed 33-30.

**THE LAST MEETING**

**(Johnson C. Smith 19, Saint Augustine's College 13 - Oct. 11, 2008 - Charlotte, N.C.)** - The Golden Bulls scored 16 straight points in the final 6:34 of the fourth quarter to pull out a win over the Falcons. Kenny Strickland grabbed an 18-yard pass from Carlton Richardson with 1:04 remaining in the fourth quarter for the game-winning touchdown. Walter Sanders rushed 22 times for 99 yards, and Kris Brownlee tossed two touchdown passes to Jone' Harris to lead the Falcons. Steven Stanback led the Falcons with 11 total tackles. The Falcons led 13-3 heading into the fourth quarter.

**LAST WEEK FOR SAINT AUGUSTINE'S COLLEGE**

**(Shaw 42, Saint Augustine's College 32 - Oct. 3, 2009 - Raleigh, N.C.)** - The Falcons lost a tough game to their crosstown rival at Millbrook High School after leading 17-3 in the second quarter. The Bears outscored the Falcons 38-15 the rest of the game for the victory. Kris Brownlee (R-So./Philadelphia, Pa.) led the Falcons with a rushing touchdown and a passing touchdown to Tyron Laughinghouse (Fr./Greenville, N.C.). Arnold Mullins (Jr./Philadelphia, Pa.) scored a touchdown and a two-point conversion for the Falcons. LaBranzo Rish (So./Columbia, S.C.) scored on a 54-yard interception return for the Falcons with 3:10 left before halftime. Adison Daniels (Sr./Raleigh, N.C.) booted the extra point after the interception return for a 17-3 Falcon lead. The Bears scored near the end of the second quarter to close the margin to 17-10 at halftime. The Bears gained 358 total offensive yards and the Falcons amassed 312 total offensive yards. It marked the third consecutive game that the Falcons gained over 300-plus yards of offense. Linebacker Justin Johnson (Fr./Opelika, Ala.) sparked the Falcons' defense with 11 tackles. Linebacker Mark Hall (Jr./Suitland, Md.) added eight tackles for the Falcons.

## LAST WEEK FOR JOHNSON C. SMITH UNIVERSITY

**(Johnson C. Smith 30, Livingstone 15 - Oct. 3, 2009 - Salisbury, N.C.)** - Johnson C. Smith defeated Livingstone in the inaugural Commemorative Classic at Alumni Memorial Stadium on Livingstone's campus. The Golden Bulls rallied after trailing 9-3 at halftime. Ryan Carter threw two touchdown passes and Quinton Toomer scored on touchdown rushes of 60 and 73 yards to spark the comeback. Toomer was named the Most Outstanding Player of the game after gaining 157 yards and two touchdowns on only seven carries.

## THE HEAD COACHES

**Michael Costa** is in his eighth season as head coach at Saint Augustine's College. He is one of the most respected head coaches in the CIAA. The 2003 and 2005 CIAA football coach of the year, Costa is an energetic leader who instills discipline and intensity in his players. Costa is the Falcons' only head coach since the school revived football in 2002. During his tenure at Saint Augustine's College, Costa has produced three All-Americans (Kevin Jones, Alex Hall, Marcus Kennedy) and 21 All-CIAA players including eight first-team selections. Several former players have gone on to professional careers, including former standout Alex Hall, who currently plays for the NFL's Cleveland Browns. Some have embarked on coaching careers such as 2005 CIAA defensive player of the year Tyrone Pettaway, who is an assistant on the University of Tennessee staff. The Falcons have achieved several noteworthy accomplishments during Costa's reign. In 2005, the Falcons were the first CIAA team to earn a No. 1 ranking in the NCAA Division II Southeast Region. That same year, the Falcons tied a school record with eight wins. From 2005 to 2007, the defense was ranked in the top 10 nationally in total defense. The Falcons gained national attention with wins over nationally-ranked Catawba (14-7) in 2008 and Mars Hill (13-6) in 2005. Both teams play in the highly-regarded South Atlantic Conference. Costa received a bachelor of science degree in Health and Physical Education from Norfolk State University. Costa and his wife, Cassandra, are the proud parents of two children, Michael III and Alyse Nicole.

**Steven Aycock** is in his first season as head football coach at Johnson C. Smith. Aycock was the offensive line coach for the Golden Bulls from 2005 to 2008 before he was elevated to the head coaching position. This is his second stint at JCSU. Aycock was the recruiting coordinator for the Golden Bulls from 1995 to 1997. He was also the offensive line coach at Savannah State from 1994-1995 and the recruiting coordinator at Savannah State from 1997-2000. During his collegiate playing days, Aycock was an offensive lineman at Savannah State from 1988 to 1992.

## RODRIGUEZ, HARRIS NAMED CIAA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

The Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) honored football players Ricky Rodriguez and Jone' Harris of Saint Augustine's College on Sept. 28. Rodriguez was named CIAA offensive lineman of the week, and Harris was chosen CIAA receiver of the week. Rodriguez, who plays center, is the second Falcon since 2002 to win the offensive lineman award.

## COSTA NAMED CIAA FOOTBALL COACH OF THE WEEK

Head Coach Michael Costa of Saint Augustine's College was selected CIAA football coach of the week on Sept. 21 after directing the Falcons to a victory in their CIAA opener on Sept. 19. He led the Falcons to a 27-14 triumph over Virginia State University. The win was the first this season for the Falcons, who snapped a three-game losing streak. This is the sixth time that Costa has been chosen CIAA football coach of the week.

## GREEN NAMED NATIONAL CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Quarterback Joaquin (pronounced Wa-KEEN) Green of Saint Augustine's College was selected D2Football.com National Co-Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 9. Green (Redshirt Fr./Pittsboro, N.C.) earned national recognition after throwing six touchdown passes in a 43-41 three overtime loss to the University of Charleston (W.Va.) on Sept. 5 in only his second collegiate start. He tied the Division II national record for most touchdown passes by a freshman in one game, which is shared by five other players. Green, who was named CIAA football rookie of the week on Sept. 21, also set a Saint Augustine's College school record in the modern era. Green completed 20 of 33 passes for 228 yards, six touchdowns and one interception against Charleston.

**GREEN, HARRIS EARN CIAA FOOTBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS**

Tight end Jone' Harris (Jr./Fairfield, Calif.) and quarterback Joaquin (Pronounced Wa – KEEN) Green (Redshirt Fr./Pittsboro, N.C.) of Saint Augustine's College captured CIAA football player of the week awards on Sept. 7. Harris was named CIAA receiver of the week after catching seven passes for 93 yards and three touchdowns in a 43-41 three overtime loss to the University of Charleston (W.Va.) on Sept. 5. The receptions, yards and touchdowns were career highs for Harris in one game. Green was selected CIAA rookie of the week after tossing six touchdown passes against the University of Charleston (W.Va.) in only his second collegiate start.

**STEVENSON NAMED D2FOOTBALL.COM PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN**

Defensive tackle Phillip Stevenson (Jr./Statesville, N.C.) of Saint Augustine's College was named to the 2009 Preseason D2football.com Division II All-America second team on Aug 18. Stevenson is the second Falcon player in school history to make the D2football.com preseason All-America team. Former Falcon defensive end Alex Hall, who currently plays for the Cleveland Browns, was a two-time selection on the squad in 2006-07.

**D2FOOTBALL.COM HONORS STEVENSON, CRUMP**

Defensive tackle Phillip Stevenson (Jr./Statesville, N.C.) of Saint Augustine's College was named 2009 D2football.com Preseason CIAA Defensive Player of the Year on Aug. 17. Stevenson joins teammate Marcus Crump (Redshirt Sr./Pittsboro, N.C.) on the 2009 D2football.com Preseason All-CIAA team.

**FALCONS EARN HIGH PRESEASON CIAA FOOTBALL RANKING**

Saint Augustine's College is predicted to finish near the top of the CIAA according to the 2009 preseason football poll, which was released July 23 at the CIAA Football Press Conference and Luncheon held in Jones Dining Hall on the campus of Virginia State University. With 52 lettermen returning, including 16 starters, the Falcons are picked to finish fourth in the conference and third in the CIAA's Western Division.
