THE EVENT

Saint Augustine's College visits Fayetteville State University on Homecoming Day for the Broncos. This game has major implications on the CIAA Western Division race. The Falcons can move into a first-place tie with a victory. A loss would give the Broncos the division title with one game remaining for both teams.

THE SERIES

The Broncos lead the series 10-5 overall including victories in the last two games between both teams. The Broncos won 13-10 in 2007 and 20-16 in 2008. Both contests were played in Raleigh, N.C. The last time the Falcons won was 15-3 in 2006. The game was played in Fayetteville, N.C., on the Broncos' Homecoming Day. The Broncos are 4-3 against the Falcons at home.

THE LAST MEETING

(Fayetteville State 20, Saint Augustine's College 16 - Oct. 25, 2008 - Raleigh, N.C.) - Turnovers was the difference in this contest between Western Division rivals. The Falcons threw five interceptions including one on a Hail Mary pass in the end zone on the game's final play. Adrian Horton picked off three passes for the Broncos. Overall, the Falcons committed seven turnovers compared to three for the Broncos. JaTaurus White scored two touchdowns for the Falcons including a pass from Kris Brownlee. Adison Daniels added a 36-yard field goal and an extra point. White's first touchdown gave the Falcons an early 7-0 lead, but the Broncos led 20-10 in the third quarter on a short touchdown run by Calvin Harris. White scored on a short run for the final margin. Stephan Stanback led the Falcons with 10 total tackles, and Terrel Allen of FSU led all tacklers with 11.

LAST WEEK FOR SAINT AUGUSTINE'S COLLEGE

(Saint Augustine's College 31, Livingstone 7 - Oct. 17, 2009 - Raleigh, N.C.) - Saint Augustine's College celebrated Homecoming/Senior Day with an easy win over Livingstone College before a capacity crowd at Broughton High School Stadium. The win kept the Falcons (3-5 overall, 3-2 CIAA) in the CIAA Western Division title hunt with two games remaining in the regular season. The Falcons are one game behind division leader Fayetteville State University (4-1 CIAA) heading into their showdown Saturday in Fayetteville, N.C. at 2 p.m. Defense and special teams carried the Falcons until the offense came alive late in the second half. The Falcons struck first in the first quarter when Tyron Laughinghouse (Fr./Greenville, N.C.) scored on a 43-yard punt return and Adison Daniels (Sr./Raleigh, N.C.) kicked the extra point. Daniels added a 20-yard field goal in the second quarter for a 10-0 halftime lead. In the first half, the

Falcons had 130 yards of total offense and one interception. But a rock-solid defense limited the Blue Bears to eight total yards. Defense sparked the Falcons in the third quarter when defensive end Marcus Crump (Redshirt Sr./Pittsboro, N.C.) picked up a fumble and rambled seven yards for a touchdown, ending the run with an emphatic leap in the end zone over a Blue Bear player. Daniels booted the extra point for a 17-0 lead. Tailback Walter Sanders (Jr./Baltimore, Md.) finished off the Blue Bears with two touchdown runs covering 38 and 28 yards in the fourth quarter. Daniels kicked both extra points. Sandwiched between both scoring runs was a seven-yard pass from reserve quarterback Bryan Aycoth to Terril Gourdine for the Blue Bears (0-8 overall, 0-5 CIAA) only touchdown. Jordan Beckham kicked the point after attempt. After a slow start, the Falcons ended with 326 total offensive yards. This is the fifth game in a row that the Falcons have gained over 300 offensive yards and scored 27 or more points, all against CIAA foes. Sanders rushed for 101 yards and two touchdowns on eight carries after entering the game in the second half. Reserve quarterback Kris Brownlee (Redshirt So./Philadelphia, Pa.) gained 70 yards on 11 carries, and wide receiver Richard Abney (Sr./Capital Heights, Md.) had four catches for 80 yards for the Falcons. The defense recorded seven quarterback sacks, forced three turnovers and limited the Blue Bears to 56 total yards including minus 22 net rushing yards. This is the second consecutive contest an opponent has rushed for negative yards against the Falcons. Linebacker Mark Hall (Sr./Suitland, Md.) led the Falcons with 10 total tackles. Crump, this week's CIAA defensive lineman of the week, added nine total tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks, his second straight multi-sack game. Alkeem Deloatch led the Blue Bears with 10 total tackles. This was the last home game for seniors Richard Boone (Petersburg, Va.), Mario Castellanos (Anaheim, Calif.), Damon Gibson (Suitland, Md.), Michael Gillespie (Statesville, Ga.), Cecil Jones (Fayetteville, N.C.), Stephan Stanback (Temple Hills, Md.), Abney, Crump, Daniels and Hall.

LAST WEEK FOR FAYETTEVILLE STATE

(Fayetteville State 30, Johnson C. Smith 12 - Oct. 17, 2009 - Charlotte, N.C.)

- The Broncos roared back from a first-half deficit for a big win against the Golden Bulls. Richard Medlin and Calvin Harris combined for 336 yards rushing in the win, the Broncos' ninth over the Golden Bulls since 2000. Harris rushed 26 times for a career-high 187 yards and a touchdown. Over the last three games -- all Broncos wins -- Harris is averaging 139 yards per game. Two first-half turnovers, a punt return for a touchdown and a safety left FSU trailing 12-7 at halftime. The Broncos responded in the second half, scoring 23 consecutive points en route to its fifth straight road win. This season the Broncos are allowing only 12.3 points per game on the road. FSU's last road loss was a 19-12 setback to Shaw on Oct. 12, 2008. Tyler Hosler, making just his third career start for the Broncos, had his best game. The junior quarterback finished 16-of-23 for 188 yards and a touchdown.

THE HEAD COACHES

Michael Costa is in his eighth season as head coach at Saint Augustine's College. He is one of the most respected head coaches in the CIAA. The 2003 and 2005 CIAA football coach of the year, Costa is an energetic leader who instills discipline and intensity in his players. Costa is the Falcons' only head coach since the school revived football in 2002. During his tenure at Saint Augustine's College, Costa has produced three All-Americans (Kevin Jones, Alex Hall, Marcus Kennedy) and 21 All-CIAA players including eight first-team selections. Several former players have gone on to professional careers, including former standout Alex Hall, who currently plays for the NFL's Cleveland Browns. The Falcons have achieved several noteworthy accomplishments during Costa's reign. In 2005, the Falcons were the first CIAA team to earn a No. 1 ranking in the NCAA Division II Southeast Region. That same year, the Falcons tied a school record with eight wins. From 2005 to 2007, the defense was ranked in the top 10 nationally in total defense. The Falcons gained national attention with wins over nationally-ranked Catawba (14-7) in 2008 and Mars Hill (13-6) in 2005. Both teams play in the highly-regarded South Atlantic Conference. Costa received a bachelor of science degree in Health and Physical Education from Norfolk State University.

Kenny Phillips is in his 10th season as head coach at Fayetteville State University. His Bronco teams won the CIAA title in 2002 and 2003, and reached the CIAA championship game in 2004. He was named most outstanding coach in the 2002 title game, and was selected CIAA coach of the year in 2002. He was named Washington, D.C., Pigskin Coach of the year in 2002 and 2004. This season, the Broncos were picked to have the best team in the CIAA.

CRUMP, HALL WIN CIAA PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARDS

The Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) honored defensive end Marcus Crump (Redshirt Sr./Pittsboro, N.C.) and outside linebacker Mark Hall (Sr./Suitland, Md.) of Saint Augustine's College on Monday (Oct. 19). Crump won CIAA defensive lineman of the week honors for the second week in a row, and Hall was named CIAA linebacker of the week. Crump (6-6, 240 pounds) returned a fumble seven yards for a touchdown in a 31-7 win over Livingstone College on Homecoming/Senior Day this past Saturday (Oct. 17) at Broughton High School Stadium. He also recorded 9 total tackles including 3.5 tackles for loss and 2.5 quarterback sacks. Crump, the Falcons' sacks leader with seven, has won four CIAA weekly awards during his collegiate football career. Hall (5-9, 175 pounds) led the Falcons with 10 total tackles against Livingstone. The total tied for the most tackles in the game. This is the first CIAA weekly award for Hall, who leads the Falcons with 63 total tackles.

FALCONS GETTING OFFENSIVE AGAINST LEAGUE FOES

The Falcons have gained over 300 yards and scored 27 points or better in their last five games, all against CIAA teams. Overall, the Falcons are third in the CIAA in third-down conversions (38.7 percent) which has allowed them to rank second in the CIAA in time of possession (32:30 minutes per game). The Broncos rank second in the league in red zone offense (84.4 percent).

GREEN NAMED NATIONAL CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Quarterback Joaquin (pronounced Wa – KEEN) Green of Saint Augustine's College was selected D2Football.com National Co-Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 9. Green (Redshirt Fr./Pittsboro, N.C.) earned national recognition after throwing six touchdown passes in a 43-41 three overtime loss to the University of Charleston (W.Va.) on Sept. 5 in only his second collegiate start. He tied the Division II national record for most touchdown passes by a freshman in one game, which is shared by five other players. Green, who was named CIAA football rookie of the week on Sept. 21, also set a Saint Augustine's College school record in the modern era. Green completed 20 of 33 passes for 228 yards, six touchdowns and one interception against Charleston.
