THE EVENT

Saint Augustine's College hosts Livingstone College on Homecoming/Senior Day. This is the last home game for seniors Richard Abney, Richard Boone, Mario Castellanos, Sherman Cauthen, Marcus Crump, Adison Daniels, Damon Gibson, Mark Hall, Stephan Stanback and Alonzo Tatmon, Jr. A victory over the winless Blue Bears would keep the Falcons in contention for the Western Division title and a berth in the CIAA Championship Game. The Falcons enter the contest tied with Shaw and Johnson C. Smith for second place at 2-2. Fayetteville State leads the division at 3-1.

THE SERIES

The Falcons lead the series 11-3-2 including the last six victories. In 2008, the Falcons won 28-6 in Salisbury, N.C. The last time both teams played in Raleigh, N.C., the Falcons won 31-16 on Oct. 21., 2006. The Falcons are 6-1 overall including 2-1 at home in the series since 2002.

THE LAST MEETING

(Saint Augustine's College 28, Livingstone 6 - Oct. 18, 2008 - Salisbury, N.C.) - The Falcons pulled away in the second half for an easy victory in Alumni Memorial Stadium. Kris Brownlee threw one touchdown and ran for another score to lead the Falcons. Walter Sanders rushed for 153 yards on 20 carries including a 24-yard touchdown that gave the Falcons the lead for good at 14-6 in the second quarter. Myron Miller scored on a 20-yard interception return and Brownlee ran 11 yards for a touchdown in the second half to put the game away. The Blue Bears led early 7-0 on a 25-yard pass from Bryan Aycoth to Rashaad Flucker, but the Falcons came back to tie the game when Brownlee hit Jamain Smith for a seven-yard touchdown pass. The Falcons rushed for 224 yards while holding the Blue Bears to 66 rushing yards and forcing two interceptions. Marcus Kennedy led the Falcons with nine total tackles including three tackles for loss and Alkeem Deloach led the Blue Bears with 9 tackles.

LAST WEEK FOR SAINT AUGUSTINE'S COLLEGE

(Saint Augustine's College 27, Johnson C. Smith 9 - Oct. 10, 2009 - Raleigh, N.C.) - The win snapped a two-game losing streak, and kept the Falcons in the race for the Western Division title and a berth in the CIAA Championship Game. The Falcons set season highs for total offensive yards (415) and rushing yards (246) against the Golden Bulls. Tailback Arnold Mullins (Jr./Philadelphia, Pa.) finished with a season-high 104 yards on 20 carries and a touchdown. Kris Brownlee (R-So./Philadelphia, Pa.), the second quarterback in a two-QB system, added 74 yards on 12 rushes for

the Falcons. Starting quarterback Joaquin Green (R-Fr./Pittsboro, N.C.) completed 14-for-19 passes for 151 yards and a score. Eighty-nine of those yards went to Tyron Laughinghouse (Fr./Greenville, NC) on six catches. The offense allowed the Falcons to win the time of possession 39:17 to 20:43. Mullins and tailback Walter Sanders (Jr./Baltimore, Md.) each ran for a short touchdown, and Adison Daniels (Sr./Raleigh, N.C.) added a 41-yard field goal and two extra points for a 17-3 lead at halftime. The lead extended to 27-3 in the second half on a 37-yard field goal and extra point by Daniels and a short pass from Green to Richard Abney (Capital Heights, Md.). The Golden Bulls scored finally scored late in the fourth quarter on a 19-yard Ryan Carter pass to Kenny Strickland after struggling to move the ball throughout the game. The Golden Bulls struggled on the ground against an air-tight Falcons' defense which limited the visitors to -2 net rushing yards and 139 total offensive yards. The Falcons were 6 of 11 on third-down conversions while the Golden Bulls were 1 of 8. The Falcons compiled five quarterback sacks including three for defensive end Marcus Crump (Sr./Pittsboro, N.C.) and two for linebacker Mark Hall (Jr./Suitland, Md.), who led the team with 8 total tackles and also had a fumble recovery. Crump had 7 total tackles and linebacker Steven Stanback (Jr./Temple Hills, Md.) had six total tackles, three tackles for loss and two forced fumbles. The offensive and defensive display by the Falcons overshadowed 14 penalties for 137 yards. The Golden Bulls committed 10 penalties for 92 yards. Carter completed 13 of 17 passes for 141 yards and a touchdown for the Golden Bulls. Perrin Carr IV of the Golden Bulls led all tacklers with 11 and had one forced fumble.

LAST WEEK FOR LIVINGSTONE COLLEGE

(Chowan 42, Livingstone 33 - Oct. 10, 2009 - Salisbury, N.C.) - Steven Williams three for 279 yards and three touchdowns and ran for 130 yards and another score in the loss to Chowan. Alkeem Deloatch led the Blue Bears with 12 tackles and one sack. The 33 points were the most this season for the Blue Bears. They scored a combined 34 points in the previous six games. The Blue Bears trailed 14-0 in the first quarter, but closed the margin to 14-13 by halftime. Chowan opened a 35-19 lead in the fourth quarter which was too much for the Blue Bears to overcome. Omar McFadden had six receptions for 120 yards and a touchdown, and Jeremy Hughes grabbed 2 passes for 104 yards and a touchdown. The Blue Bears gained 480 total offensive yards but allowed 546 offensive yards. C.J. Westler of Chowan completed 24 of 38 passes for 352 yards and four touchdowns.

THE HEAD COACHES

Michael Costa is in his eighth season as head coach at Saint Augustine's College. He is one of the most respected head coaches in the CIAA. The 2003 and 2005 CIAA football coach of the year, Costa is an energetic leader who instills discipline and intensity in his players. Costa is the Falcons' only head coach since the school revived football in 2002. During his tenure at Saint Augustine's College, Costa has produced three All-Americans (Kevin Jones, Alex Hall, Marcus Kennedy) and 21 All-CIAA players including eight first-team selections. Several former players have gone on to professional careers, including former standout Alex Hall, who currently plays for the NFL's Cleveland Browns. Some have embarked on coaching careers such as 2005 CIAA defensive player of the year Tyrone Pettaway, who is an assistant on the University of Tennessee staff. The Falcons have achieved several noteworthy accomplishments during Costa's reign. In 2005, the Falcons were the first CIAA team to earn a No. 1 ranking in the NCAA Division II Southeast Region. That same year, the Falcons tied a school record with eight wins. From 2005 to 2007, the defense was ranked in the top 10 nationally in total defense. The Falcons gained national attention with wins over nationally-ranked Catawba (14-7) in 2008 and Mars Hill (13-6) in 2005. Both teams play in the highly-regarded South Atlantic Conference. Costa received a bachelor of science degree in Health and Physical Education from Norfolk State University. Costa and his wife, Cassandra, are the proud parents of two children, Michael III and Alyse Nicole.

Eric Brown is the interim head coach and the defensive coordinator of the Blue Bears. This is his second stint with the Blue Bears. Brown has also been an assistant coach at Edward Waters College, Methodist University, and Johnson C. Smith University. At Edward Waters, Brown coached special teams. His unit amassed 15 blocks during the 2004-2005 season. He was a standout linebacker at the University of South Carolina from 1989 to 1993. Brown graduated with a bachelors of science degree in retail management.

CRUMP NAMED CIAA DEFENSIVE LINEMAN OF THE WEEK

Marcus Crump was selected CIAA defensive lineman of the week on Monday (Oct. 12) after collecting a career-high three sacks in addition to 4.5 tackles for loss and seven total tackles against Johnson C. Smith University on Oct. 10. He was 1 1/2 sacks away from tying the modern school single-game record set by Alex Hall in 2006. Hall had 4.5 sacks against Johnson C. Smith three years ago. Crump has won three CIAA weekly awards during his career including his first this season.

FALCONS GETTING OFFENSIVE AGAINST LEAGUE FOES

The Falcons are averaging 377.3 yards and 28.3 points in four games against CIAA teams. Overall, the Falcons are leading the CIAA in third-down conversions (39.8 percent) which has allowed them to rank third in the CIAA in time of possession (32:48 minutes per game). By contrast, Livingstone ranks last in the league in third-down conversions (25.5 percent)

GREEN NAMED NATIONAL CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Quarterback Joaquin (pronounced Wa – KEEN) Green of Saint Augustine’s College was selected D2Football.com National Co-Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 9. Green (Redshirt Fr./Pittsboro, N.C.) earned national recognition after throwing six touchdown passes in a 43-41 three overtime loss to the University of Charleston (W.Va.) on Sept. 5 in only his second collegiate start. He tied the Division II national record for most touchdown passes by a freshman in one game, which is shared by five other players. Green, who was named CIAA football rookie of the week on Sept. 21, also set a Saint Augustine’s College school record in the modern era. Green completed 20 of 33 passes for 228 yards, six touchdowns and one interception against Charleston
