Saint Augustine's College 1-4 overall, 1-1 CIAA; Shaw University 4-1 overall, 1-1 CIAA.

THE EVENT

Saint Augustine's College visits crosstown rival Shaw University in a huge CIAA game. Both teams are in a four-way first-place tie in the Western Division at 1-1 along with Fayetteville State University and Johnson C. Smith University. The winner remains in the thick of the race for the Western Division title and a berth to the CIAA Championship Game.

THE SERIES

The Falcons lead the series 3-2 since 2002 including a 27-16 win over the Bears in 2008 at Broughton High School Stadium. They are 2-1 in home games and 1-1 in away games against the Bears.

THE LAST MEETING

(Saint Augustine's College 27, Shaw 16 - Oct. 4, 2008 - Raleigh, N.C.) - The Falcons gained bragging rights for the year after stunning their biggest rival 27-16 in front of 2,587 fans at Broughton High School Stadium. The Falcons entered the contest winless in the CIAA, while the Bears were unbeaten in the conference. The Falcons played like they were the defending CIAA champions instead of the Bears, however. A 70-yard return for a touchdown by Lester Graham off a missed Shaw field goal ignited the Falcons, who led 13-2 after the score. The Bears pulled within 13-8 at halftime but the Falcons opened a 27-8 lead late in the third quarter on a 14-yard touchdown run by Walter Sanders and an extra point kick by Adison Daniels. Sanders sparked the Falcons with two rushing touchdowns. Kris Brownlee completed 6-of-10 passes for 132 yards including a 20-yard touchdown pass to Jamain Smith. Defensively, the Falcons were led by Phillip Stevenson, Marcus Kennedy, Marcus Crump and Graham. They each had 10 total tackles apiece. The Bears gained more offensive yards (403-186) and kept the ball longer (35:37-24:23), but the Falcons had no turnovers while Bears committed two turnovers.

LAST WEEK FOR SAINT AUGUSTINE'S COLLEGE

(Elizabeth City State 29, Saint Augustine's College 27 - Sept. 26, 2009 - Raleigh, NC.) - Saint Augustine's College held high-powered Elizabeth City State University to a season low in total offensive yards, but was unable to pull out the victory in a 29-27 CIAA football loss at Broughton High School Stadium. The Vikings entered the game averaging a league-high 428.2 offensive yards, but were held to 172 yards. The Vikings gained over 400 yards in each of their first three games, but were held to under 200 yards for the first time this season. Meanwhile, the Falcons gained 368 offensive yards which is their second highest total this season. Despite winning the

battle in total offensive yards, the Falcons failed to win their second straight game when their 34-yard field goal attempt was blocked by Justin Hamilton as time expired. Jone' Harris (Jr./Fairfield, Calif.) led the Falcons with three receptions for 108 yards and two touchdowns, including a 34-yard leaping grab in the fourth quarter which put the Falcons ahead 27-23 with 3:02 remaining in the game. It was the second straight 100-plus yard receiving day for the Falcons' tight end. Joaquin Green of the Falcons completed 11-for-27 passes for 172 yards and two touchdowns, but he also threw two interceptions. Richard Abney caught four passes for 45 yards and a score for the Falcons. Cedric Blacknall of the Vikings rushed 10 times for 40 yards and two touchdowns, including a two-yard run with 1:22 left which turned out to be the game-winner. The Falcons drove to the Vikings' 17-yard line on their next possession where they attempted the potential winning field goal with three seconds left. Hamilton's block preserved the victory for the Vikings. Creven Powell completed 6 of 18 passes for 107 yards and a touchdown, but he threw two interceptions, one to Jamil Berry (So./Jonesboro, Ga.) and the other to Charles McKenzie (Jr./Warner Robins, Ga.). Linebacker Steven Stanback paced the Falcons with 10 total tackles, and defensive end Marcus Crump (R-Sr./Pittsboro, N.C.) added seven tackles and 0.5 sacks. Kobi Williams sparked the Vikings with a game-high 11 tackles. The game, played in rainy conditions, featured six lead changes, 11 turnovers and two safeties after the ball sailed over the punter in the end zone. The Vikings scored first on Blacknall's two-yard run, but the Falcons led 10-7 at halftime on a 43-yard pass to Harris from Kris Brownlee (R-So./Philadelphia, Pa.) and a 36-yard field goal by Adison Daniels (Sr./Raleigh, N.C.). The Vikings regained the lead 16-10 on a safety and an eight-yard run by Daronte McNeill. The Falcons countered by scoring on a safety and a six-yard pass to Abney from Green for a 19-16 lead going into the fourth quarter. There were three lead changes in the last seven frantic minutes of the fourth quarter.

LAST WEEK FOR SHAW UNIVERSITY

(Bowie State 31, Shaw 24 2OT - Sept. 26, 2009 - Bowie, Md.) - Freshman quarterback Emmanuel Yeager threw a perfect 30-yard touchdown pass to senior Larry Dixon, Jr. to lift Bowie State University to a thrilling 31-24 double overtime victory over Shaw University in the 6th Annual Prince George's Classic. Yeager, the game MVP, completed 15-of-22 passes for 128 yards and junior Rodney Webb rushed for a game and career-high 174 yards for BSU's Bulldogs. Shaw scored the first points of the afternoon following Bowie State's first miscue of the game. Shaw's LaMichael Howell scooped a Bowie State fumble and ran 58 yards untouched into the Bulldogs end zone. Caleb Reid added the extra point for an early 7-0 lead. The Bears took a 14-0 first quarter advantage following a one-yard touchdown run by Raymond Williams with 2:36 left in the opening period. Bowie State sophomore Michael Gagne kicked a 24-yard field goal at the 12:40 mark of the second quarter, capping off a 10-play, 78-yard drive, making the score 14-3. Lyncon Shepherd got those three points back after kicking a 37-yard field goal for Shaw. Sophomore Clifton Budd caught a 31-yard touchdown pass from Yeager at the 3:12 mark of the second quarter, trimming the deficit to 17-10. Shaw committed its first turnover of the game via a Bowie State interception. Bowie State's Webb wasted no time tying the game at 17-17, rumbling 47 yards to pay dirt just before the half. Both teams were scoreless in the second half. In the first overtime, Williams dashed for 24 yards, giving the Bears a 24-17 lead. The Bulldogs answered with a Webb two-yard run. Yeager connected with Dixon for the eventual game winning score. Brandon Landers threw for a game-high 140 yards and Williams rushed for a team-high 108 yards to lead Shaw on offense. Callahan Bright and Sparkman paced the Bears on defense with 10 and nine tackles, respectively.

THE HEAD COACHES

Michael Costa is in his eighth season as head coach at Saint Augustine's College. He is one of the most respected head coaches in the CIAA. The 2003 and 2005 CIAA football coach of the year, Costa is an energetic leader who instills discipline and intensity in his players. Costa is the Falcons' only head coach since the school revived football in 2002. During his tenure at Saint Augustine's College, Costa has produced three All-Americans (Kevin Jones, Alex Hall, Marcus Kennedy) and 21 All-CIAA players including eight first-team selections. Several former players have gone on to professional careers, including former standout Alex Hall, who currently plays for the NFL's Cleveland Browns. Some have embarked on coaching careers such as 2005 CIAA defensive player of the year Tyrone Pettaway, who is an assistant on the University of Tennessee staff. The Falcons have achieved several noteworthy accomplishments during Costa's reign. In 2005, the Falcons were the first CIAA team to earn a No. 1 ranking in the NCAA Division II Southeast Region. That same year,

the Falcons tied a school record with eight wins. From 2005 to 2007, the defense was ranked in the top 10 nationally in total defense. His Falcon teams own a 3-2 record over crosstown rival Shaw, the two-time defending CIAA champion. The Falcons also gained national attention with wins over nationally-ranked Catawba (14-7) in 2008 and Mars Hill (13-6) in 2005. Both teams play in the highly-regarded South Atlantic Conference.

Darrell Asberry enters his fourth year as head coach of the Shaw University football program. Under his leadership, the Bears won both the 2007 and 2008 CIAA Championships and earned a spot in the 2007 NCAA Division II playoffs. Asberry was named CIAA Coach of the Year in 2007. Asberry assumed the helm of the Shaw program in 2006. In 2007, Shaw ranked first in Division II in total defense. In 2008, Shaw ranked first in Division II in rushing defense, total defense, sacks, and tackles for a loss.

RODRIGUEZ, HARRIS NAMED CIAA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

The Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) honored football players Ricky Rodriguez and Jone' Harris of Saint Augustine's College on Monday (Sept. 28). Rodriguez was named CIAA offensive lineman of the week, and Harris was chosen CIAA receiver of the week. Rodriguez, who plays center, is the second Falcon since 2002 to win the offensive lineman award. He anchored an offensive line that helped the Falcons gain 368 total offensive yards against Elizabeth City State University this past Saturday. The offensive total was the second highest this season for the Falcons. Harris, who plays tight end, was named the CIAA's top receiver for the second time this season. He caught three passes for 108 yards and two touchdowns covering 43 and 34 yards against Elizabeth City State University. It was the second straight 100-yard plus receiving day for Harris.

RARE AWAY GAME

This is only the second away game for the Falcons this season even though the contest will be played in Raleigh, N.C. The Falcons play six home games and four away games this season.
