**Hall Selected To Play In Cactus Bowl  
*All-Star Game Features Best Seniors In Division II Football***

Defensive end Alex Hall (Glenarden, MD) of Saint Augustine's College was picked to play in the 2008 Valero Cactus Bowl, which features the best seniors in NCAA Division II football. The rosters were released on Friday, Dec. 7.

Hall, a 6-6, 260-pound preseason All-American pick, will compete for the East team.

The Cactus Bowl, set for January 11 at 7 p.m., will be regionally televised in approximately 8 million homes on Fox Sports Southwest. The game site is at Javelina Stadium in Kingsville, TX.

Hall is the Falcons' career leader in quarterback sacks (25.5) and tackles for loss (49.5) since the college resumed football in 2002. He also is the school's career leader in sacks for a season (13) and sacks for one game (4.5).

A neck stinger slowed Hall early in the season but he still made the 2007 All-CIAA first team for the second straight year. He recorded 7 sacks and 15 tackles for loss, both team highs, while leading the Falcons to a No. 6 national ranking in total defense in 2007.

As a junior in 2006, Hall was named to several All-American teams. He led the CIAA and was among the nation's leaders with 13 sacks, and he also amassed 19 tackles for loss.

Hall draws interest from NFL scouts because of his size and athleticism. Hall is listed as one of 19 Division II pro hopefuls on d2football.com, a Division II football website.

Hall is one of four CIAA players selected for the Cactus Bowl. The others are De' Audra Dix of Johnson C. Smith University, Anthony Hailstock of Virginia State University and Eric Lamoureux of Fayetteville State University.
