THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Students & Parents can obtain an application for the Upward Bound program at the school Counselor office or by visiting or contacting our office.

The student and parent must complete an application, obtain the requested recommendations, provide current household income verification (required by federal guidelines) and include their most recent grades. After the application is reviewed and processed, the student and parent will be contacted regarding acceptance into the program.

What is TRiO UPWARD BOUND?

TRiO UPWARD BOUND is a pre-college program funded by the U.S. Department of Education and sponsored by Saint Augustine’s University.



It is an innovative program aimed at increasing academic achievement levels of high school students - including those who may be economically disadvantaged and/or first generation college students, to not only succeed in high school, but to develop the skills and motivation necessary for success in college and beyond.

What would I do in UPWARD BOUND?

UPWARD BOUND students begin the program during 9th or 10th grade and participate through high school graduation.

The UPWARD BOUND student maintains regular attendance in school, attend planned sessions, meet with the UPWARD BOUND Program Coordinator and/or Advisor, and attend Saturday Sessions during the academic year.

In the summer, participants attend a six- week summer session at the campus of Saint Augustine’s University and other college or university campuses and take part in a variety of academic, social, career, and enrichment activities.
