GENERAL STATEMENT OF POSITION DUTIES:

Conducts developmentally-appropriate child forensic interviews as part of the Child Medical Exam. Collaborates with the Multi-Disciplinary Team to ensure thorough and comprehensive interviews, keeping with best-practice standards. Makes recommendations in conjunction with the multi-disciplinary team regarding child and family needs. Testifies in court in criminal and/or civil cases.

Provides evidence-based mental health therapy services to children who've experienced trauma; Provides clinical consultation as needed to TCC staff and volunteers; Completes all required documentation per Medicaid and TCC standards.

Supports the operations of The Carousel Center, including taking referrals for CMEs and Therapy Services, providing crisis intervention as needed, and other general office duties.

Education and Experience Requirements:

- Master's Degree or higher in social work or counseling.
- At least one year experience in public or non-profit victim-centered, child protective services, and/or criminal justice system.
- Equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Intermediate experience with Microsoft Office 365.
- Successful completion of a pre-employment criminal record, sex offender registry and drug screen.
- Access to reliable transportation, have a valid operator's license and proof of vehicle insurance.

Preferred Education and Experience:

- Licensed as an LCSW, LPC, or LMFT in North Carolina.
- Knowledge, training and experience in individual/group therapy, specifically for children.
- Knowledge, training and experience in child development, crime victims, trauma and crisis intervention.
- Knowledge, training and experience in forensic interviews, specifically with children.
- Training in Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TFCBT), Child and Family Traumatic Stress Intervention (CFTSI), Child and Parent Psychotherapy

(CPP), play therapy, Problem Sexual Behavior Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (PSBCBT), or equivalent.

- Training in Recognizing Abuse Disclosures and Responding (RADAR) Child Forensic Interview model.
- Knowledge and experience developing/implementing/working with multi-systemic community partnerships.
- Current First Aid/CPR Certification.

Maintains credentials by

- Engaging in professional development activities,
- Submitting CEUs or professional development documentation prior to the deadline.
- Providing a copy of current credentials for personnel files.

Conserves supervisors time by

- Problem solving.
- Performing well.
- Leading self and others.
- Contributing to team efforts.
- Following policies and procedures.
- Exercising discretion and judgment regarding when to consult your supervisor.
- Completing other duties, responsibilities and activities that may be assigned or changed with or without notice.
