ABOUT HONORS CONVOCATION

Honors Convocation is an annual celebration where the University publicly recognizes and commends students for their distinguished academic achievements. We honor students who have demonstrated academic excellence, leadership, scholarship, and community service.

There are several types of recognitions; some are based on a student's cumulative GPA (across every course and all semesters) or on semester GPA (across all courses for one semester) or on excellence in a particular area of study. The names of the honorees appear in this program for each type of recognition.

To be honored on the President's List of Scholars, students must achieve a cumulative grade point average of 3.65 or higher. Similarly, the Provost's List of Scholars includes students who achieved a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 to 3.64w.

Based on a single semester's GPA, students can also be named on the Dean's List for Spring or for Fall or both, if they achieved a grade point average of 3.0 or better during that semester.

Each School within the University presents an award to their outstanding senior who has achieved academic excellence as well as having participated in various other extracurricular activities. Similar criteria are considered for the program awards within each school. First-year traditional students achieving a 4.0 grade point average during their first semester are awarded the Freshman Scholar Certificate. Students are also recognized for their achievements as Honors College Scholars, NCAA Scholar-Athletes and External and Presidential Scholarship recipients. Saint Augustine's University will also recognize members of national honor societies certified by The Association of College Honor Societies.

To all honored students, their parents and supporters, the University extends its sincere congratulations.

SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

DR. RAEDEEN RUSSELL

2010 Graduate of Saint Augustine's University



"Wouldn't Take Nothing for my Journey Now" written by the late Maya Angelou is one of my favorite books. I read it at the age of thirteen years and the message I valued then is what I hold dear today. That book taught me to value my life and my own story. I have had a life filled with unexpected twists and turns, but I truly, would not trade my journey with anyone.

I migrated to the United States in 2006 upon receiving a full academic scholarship in the form of a Presidential Scholarship from Saint Augustine's University (SAU), formerly Saint Augustine's College. While at "The Aug", I was involved in the Christian Fellowship Organization, Honda Campus All-Star Challenge Quiz Team, Honors program, Student Leaders Organization and wore the Miss Student Leader's crown my sophomore year, Chief of Staff to the Student Government Association and student representative on the Campus Judicial Board. I was a Dean's List Scholar, Who's Who among America's Colleges and Universities, and in 2010, received the Department

of Biology Highest Class Average Award, the Division of Natural Sciences and Mathematics Top Student Award and the recognized as the graduating class valedictorian.

It was during my time at SAU that I became interested in research and in Microbiology in particular. Dr. Mark Melton wisely advised my cohort and me to use our summers to gain exposure to bench research, and it was my debut in research as a Howard Hughes Scholar studying pathogenic proteins secreted by *Yersinia pestis* (the causative agent of plague) that served as the motivation for my academic journey. A Microbiology course taught by Dr. Doreen Cunningham later fueled my research interest.

I graduated from SAU and matriculated at Georgia State University (GSU) where I pursued a Master of Science in Biology with a concentration in Applied and Environmental Microbiology. During my tenure at GSU, I conducted bench research on contact-lens associated *Acanthamoeba*-keratitis, and did a short secondary project characterizing alternative sigma factors in *Bacillus anthracis* that causes anthrax disease. Before completing GSU, I was inducted into the Phi Beta Delta National Honor Society for International Scholars and studied abroad in Taiwan, where a course in antibiotic resistance piqued my interest in host-microbial interaction.

After graduation from GSU, I was contracted as an Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education (ORISE) Fellow at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) where I produced Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) virus-like particles (VLPs) for the testing of samples received from the National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey (NHANES). I had a short stint at the CDC because my interest in the host-microbial axis led me to apply and later matriculate at Morehouse School of Medicine (MSM) where I conducted my dissertation research on the role of exosomes in chlamydial immunity.

At MSM, I was internally awarded top student in Research Data Analysis. Externally, I received numerous travel awards from multiple organizations to present my research at local, national and international conferences, awarded the American Society for Microbiology Robert Watkins Fellowship and authored

3 peer-reviewed publications. In 2016, I received a German Academic Student Exchange (DAAD) scholarship to conduct summer research in Germany at IMD Natural Solutions. In 2018, I was selected to represent MSM at the Conference of Southern Graduate Schools (CSGS) 3-Minute Thesis Competition after receiving the First Place Judge's Award and the People's Choice Award for my presentation entitled, "The Idioms of Silence in Chlamydial Disease". That same year, I was the captain of a 4-woman group that obtained an honorable mention by the Association for Prevention Teaching and Research (APTR) for participating in the National Video Competition aimed at solving the opioid epidemic. In May 2018, I graduated from MSM with dual Doctor of Philosophy in Biomedical Sciences and Master of Science in Clinical Research (PhD/MSCR) degrees. Since graduating from MSM, I accepted a postdoctoral fellowship in Microbiology and Immunology at Emory University where I conduct research on the host immune response to Group A Streptococcal infection. Most recently, I was accepted into medical school to further pursue my dream of becoming a physician-scientist. My desire is to specialize in Family Medicine as a physician and to continue conducting research on host immune response to infectious agents as a scientist.

Besides academics, I am involved in community service activities. I formerly volunteered as a kitchen staff at the Atlanta Center for Self-Sufficiency and the Odyssey III shelters in Atlanta. Currently, I volunteer as a nurse's aide in triage at the Physician's Care Clinic where I help to serve the unemployed and uninsured members of my community. I am also active in my local church where I have received numerous awards for involvement as a Youth Leader and dance choreographer for both youth and adult dance ministries. Recently, I received a 30 Under 30 Caribbean American Emerging Leaders Award from the Institute of Caribbean Studies for my continued support of programs in Jamaica that provide meals for inner-city youths, and the establishment of a scholarship that offers funding to assist indigent students in a high school in my former hometown in Saint James, Jamaica.

Many will say that success is intentional, and whereas I agree, I somewhat disagree. I disagree because I did not plan this journey and probably would not have stumbled upon these opportunities had I chartered the course I originally planned. I however agree that success is intentional, because whereas I did not plan these specific successes, I was intentional as I made the necessary sacrifices to hone my skills in an effort to be the best me possible. I work hard in my academics and in my non-academic involvements because I believe that mediocrity is a sin and a lack of community engagement is a crime against humanity. Therefore, I live everyday with passion, knowing that every breathe is an opportunity to do and to be.

My philosophy is, "With Christ all things are possible and with a smile I can conquer any storm."

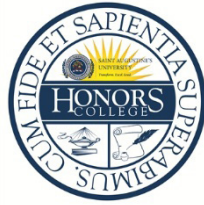

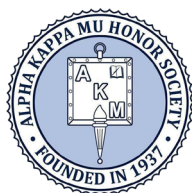
