## FRESHMAN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

High School GPA of 2.0+, calculated based on the following credits:

- English: 4 units (3 must be complete and 1 in progress)
- Mathematics: 3 units (1 unit must be Algebra 1)
- Science: 3 units
- Social Science: 2 units
- Electives: 10 units
- SAT scores of 420 (evidence-based reading and writing) and 420 (math) or ACT scores of 17 (English or reading) and 17 (math)
- Recommendation letters are not required but are accepted

## FINANCIAL AID

100% of students at St. Augustine's University receive scholarships or financial aid. Claiming an excellent education that prepares you for a meaningful career is possible and affordable at SAU. To be eligible for the greatest share of financial assistance, we encourage each student to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov).
