**ALL students must carry health insurance. International students are required to use the school plan health insurance. ANY student who has out-of-state MEDICAID (not from North Carolina) must show proof of insurance or purchase the school's insurance.

**VA benefits: Students who are receiving VA benefits, should be covered under their insurance, however, they too, have the chance to opt-out of the school insurance.

**Students who carry more than 18 credits hours pay an overload charge of \$457 per credit hour. Students with less than 12 credit hours are charged a part-time rate of \$457 per credit hour.

** Housing deposits are required prior to coming to SAU, the cost of is \$200.00 per student. Room charges vary based on the residence hall selected.

****All Students will pay a \$100 towards a payment plan, if you do not require a payment plan, all fees should be paid in full by the start of the semester.**

Important Financial Information

The total amount for a semester is due at registration. If you are expecting financial aid (federal aid, scholarships) If you are unable to pay your tuition in full, please go to Student Accounts to make a payment arrangement. There is a \$100.00 fee for payment arrangements. All payments are due by the 15th of each month, if payment is not received by the 20th of the month, your account will be assessed a late fee of \$25.00.

When registering for class, you must pay the \$100 fee at registration as a "good faith" payment, this fee will be applied to your student account. Payments may be made by cash, check, money order, or by using your **Online Portal**.

All payments and deposits are non-refundable. If you do not drop or withdraw from the University during the drop/add period, your fees will be charged accordingly.

Room (boarding) charges – these fees are non-refundable, if you have extenuating circumstances, this may be addressed on a case-by-case basis. (Note: deciding mid-way through the semester to move off campus is not an extenuating circumstances)

Student Health Insurance - Full-time students are required to have health insurance. Saint Augustine's University offers student health insurance coverage through United Health Care. The annual policy period is August 1, 2023 – July 31, 2024. Periods of coverage are annual, Fall Semester, Spring, & Summer semester. Each period of coverage has a Waiver and Enrollment Deadline. Eligibility requirements allow you to submit an insurance waiver that provides information on your existing services. Students that do not produce evidence of insurance coverage by the deadline will automatically be enrolled in the University's insurance plan and the fee for the student health insurance coverage will be charged to the student's account. **Students who are covered by out of state Medicaid, will not be covered.** If you are covered by private insurance through your parents, your insurance will be honored. International students must purchase school insurance.

All individual expenses incurred by a student, in an emergency or otherwise, will be billed to the student's account and must be paid immediately. Students are encouraged to obtain adequate insurance coverage for loss or damaged personal property. **The University does not insure personal property.**
