Payments can be made at Student Accounts 2nd floor of Delany Building.

If you register after the second payment due date, then 50% of your balance is due within 5 calendar days from the date of registration. For classes starting after the last payment due date, full payment is due prior to the start of class. If you receive Financial Aid any balance left is your responsibility, and you are required to pay 25% of that balance. A payment plan fee will be charged to your account if your account is not satisfied within the first month of attending the semester.

A late payment fee will be charged to your account after the 20th of the month unless your account has been paid in full or financial aid is in place to cover all your charges.

When time permits, we attempt to contact students at risk of being deregistered from their class selections by phone (voice or text) and/or e-mail. If you are unable to remit payment(s) please discuss your payment intentions with Student Accounts immediately after registering for classes. Please keep in mind financial aid eligibility, scholarships, alternative payment arrangements or other funding sources are also considered as forms of payment. The university recommends FASTChoice as an alternative private loan lender. See our website for types of aid available.

Do not rely on deregistration to remove you from class. It is your responsibility to withdraw from a class if you are no longer taking the class or if you have missed a substantial amount of class time. If you choose to withdraw from Saint Augustine's University, please go to the Registrar's Office in Delany Hall to formally withdraw from the university. Please understand you are financially liable for any funds received through Financial Aid.
